<b>Project Description</b>	<p>The Socio-Spatial Analysis Chair Group of the Wageningen University and Research Center has hired TreeVelop to assist their project acquisition in order to link theory and practice of sustainable tourism in the countries of South Eastern Europe. During project implementation a series of project proposal for different donors and funding agencies in the Netherlands and the European Union have to be prepared. Several proposals dealt with the promotion of sustainable tourism in the Croatian county of Sibenik-Knin. Two proposals focused on the set-up of a pan European network of scientists working in the field of tourism in protected nature parks/reserves in close cooperation with the PAN Park Foundation. Recent proposals included the promotion of cooperation of Higher Education Institutions in 7 African countries (EU EDULINK programme - 3A STEP project) and a NUFFIC proposal for HEI cooperation in Ethiopia. Two Erasmus Mundus proposals have been developed as well as several concept papers for the COST programme. The themes of the Chair Group are: Tourism in protected area's, Cultural Heritage development and protection and Socio-economic developments through tourism.</p>
